 ...made more than \$32.6 million in capital improvements

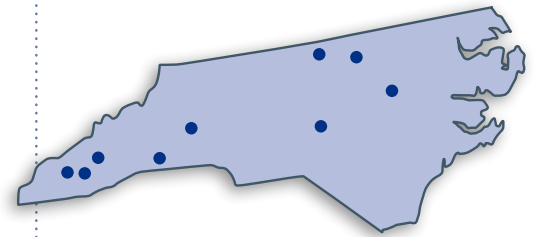
 ...distributed a payroll of \$426,327,610 to more than 6,100 employees
